







In addition to the infestations located in Manhattan, Brooklyn, and Queens areas, the Asian Longhorned Beetle was first found on Long Island in September of 1996. The proposed treatment areas are located in Massapequa Park, East Lindenhurst, West Lindenhurst, and Islip. The proposed treatment areas total approximately 1,166 sq. miles.
