IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF BRAZIL FOR ORNAMENTAL FISH EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES

The shipment of fish must be accompanied by a U.S. Origin Health Certificate issued by a competent authority and endorsed by a U.S. D.A. Veterinary Services (VS) veterinarian. The certificate shall contain the name and address of both the consignor and consignee and identification of the fish to be exported. Additional information shall include:

IDENTIFICATION

1. Provide quantity and identification of species being shipped.
2. Provide country of origin and name and address of exporter.
3. Provide country of destination and name and address of importer.

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

1. The fish originate from an establishment that is regularly inspected, and where during the 90 days prior to shipment, no transmissible diseases were reported to have occurred.
2. The fish were examined at the time of shipment and showed no signs of disease.
3. The fish were packaged in new containers.
