IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF GUATEMALA
FOR FROZEN BOVINE SEMEN EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES

The semen must be accompanied by a U.S. Origin Health Certificate issued by a veterinarian accredited by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), and endorsed by a Veterinary Services veterinarian. The certificate shall contain the name and address of the consignor and consignee, and complete identification of the semen to be exported. Additional information shall include:

I. IDENTIFICATION OF THE SEMEN LOT

- a. Name and address of the center producing the semen;
- b. Name of the donor bull;
- c. Number and identification of semen ampoules, straws, or tubes;
- d. Date of collection of the semen.

II. CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

1. The donor bulls are free of any clinical signs of blue tongue, enzootic bovine leukosis, paratuberculosis, infectious bovine rhinotracheitis, bovine viral diarrhea, trichomoniasis, vibriosis, tuberculosis, and brucellosis.
